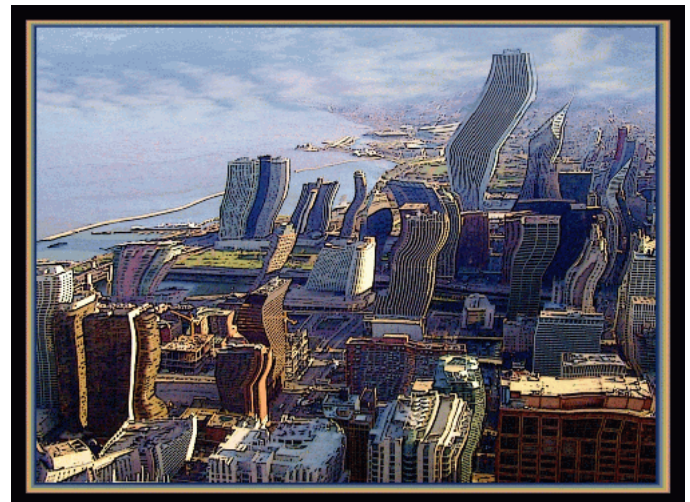
We have another month at Café Pomegranate lined up - one of the months: May-June-July - again, I'll let you know.
