Titles and Metadata for 6C Digital Entries

Jim Hawkins

I have learned that George Ziegler had to modify some files for me that were going forward to 6C Interclub Competition. If he hadn't helped me out they would have been rejected without a showing! What I hadn't realized was that 6C updated their digital file requirements just this past March. So, I have gone online for the updated information which I condense and summarize for everyone here.

According to "Guidelines for submitting digital images to 6C (March 2008)"

All competition images must be JPEG, must fit within a 1050x1050 pixel matrix, and must be saved in the sRGB colorspace. Each file should be named following this pattern:

- {club-abbreviation}-{category abbreviation}-image title
- e.g. for {Light and Shadow}-{Pictorial}-{This is my picture}
- .. the filename would be: LS-Pic-This is my picture.jpg

In the naming, Category abbreviations are:

Pic-Pictorial;

Cre-Creative;

Nat-Nature;

Trv-Travel;

PJ-Photojournalism.

The Club Abbreviation for Light and Shadow is LS.

Finally, the following are important points to be observed:

- Be sure to separate the various parts of the title with Dashes (-) NOT Underscores (_)

- Limit the Image Title in the filename to 30 (or the first 30) characters (see below*)
- DO NOT include your own name in the filename, that will disqualify your image.
The **Metadata** is where you DO put your own name. Do it in the following way:
- The maker's name goes in the "**Author**" field.
- *The full Image Title goes in the "**Description**" field.

To enter Metadata in Photoshop do the following: First use "Save as" from the File menu to save your image with a title that incorporates the descriptors in the second paragraph. Then, again using the File menu, choose "File Info..." A window will open that contains fields for the two items just above. Be sure to use the "Description" field instead of the "Title" field. 6C says that requirement is there so there will be no practical limit to the length of the Image Title - especially for Nature entries.
